Re: Cell phones and other electronic devices

Cell phones, Ipods, Gameboys, other electronic devices, etc. will no longer be allowed “on a student’s person” or in a student’s locker at any time during the school day. High school students who drive to school must leave cell phones and other electronic devices in their cars during the school day. High school students who do not drive do not need to bring electronic devices to school at any time. If a non-driving high school student *needs* a cell phone for an after-school activity, the student must check the cell phone into the FCA office before first period and may pick up the cell phone after 3:30p.m.

If a cell phone or other electronic device is found on a student’s person (on or off) the following consequences will occur: first offense-the cell phone or device will be taken up and can be picked up by the student after the school day; second offense-the cell phone or device will be taken up and can only be picked up by a parent or legal guardian; third offense-the cell phone or device will be taken up and can be picked up at the end of the semester by the student or parent/legal guardian. Faith Christian Academy reserves the right to make any changes and/or additions to these policies.

Faith Christian Academy also reserves the right to search any student at any time. Lockers are the property of Faith Christian Academy and can be searched by Faith Christian Academy at any time.
